**Summary Annual Report of the Parish Council for 2010/11 (April 2010 - March 2011)**

As in past years individual volunteer Parish Councillors took responsibility for particular parts of the Council's work.

Vice-Chair Helen Barnell edited, produced and oversaw distribution (with a team of volunteers) of the 6 issues of the Newsletter which went to every household and included over 60 news items. She also managed the contract work undertaken on the Pond and Village Green by the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers and on the Billing Road bus shelter area by the Northamptonshire Probation Service Community Payback Scheme.

Kevin Ward and Helen Barnell took charge of the Council's busy and lengthy involvement in the continued development of the Joint Core Planning Strategy which had previously threatened our village and community with massive new housing development and a dual-carriageway on our doorstep. This culminated in a community 'representation' response to the second major consultation following many hours of attending meetings (especially the Nene Ridge Parishes Group and involving Senior Planners and our MP), research and writing.

Gill Ager was our Highways Representative surveying, reporting and monitoring the work of the County Council in dealing with road issues including potholes. Gill and Dawn Allingham managed the Village Spring Clean which involved 19 volunteers from the village and the collection of 30 large bin bags of litter and other waste. Dawn also completed a very thorough risk assessment for the Council and was involved, too, with the Play Area, taken over the by Parish Council in the year, and now regularly inspected by Ruth Kentigern-Fox who also served on the Safer Community Team Panel.

Many people helped the Council and community as volunteers. Terry Barnell continued his excellent work as village webmaster making 240 changes to the site in the last year alone, including the creation and maintenance of an information diary on the development of the Planning Strategy which has been widely used and praised. In the four years since the setting up of the site there have been over 32,000 accesses through the home page not only by local residents but from across the UK and overseas.

Keith Crompton, Chair of the Village Action Group, worked in partnership with the Council on the response to the Planning Strategy. Jean and Richard Sheward and John Campion were Parish Path Wardens and we owe thanks, too, to our farmers for keeping the path network open and accessible for public use throughout the year.

The Council spent £10,750 on its work which, in addition to those things already mentioned, included the maintenance of 54 streetlights (monitored by Councillor David Clayson), 3 bus shelters and the children's play area, grass cutting in the village, and maintenance of the Village Green and Pond. No Councillors claimed any expenses for their time, travel costs and administrative expenses in carrying out their work, and extensive use of free volunteer support was made. The Sargeant Memorial Hall Committee was supported in its successful application for a £1500 grant from the NCC Councillors' Empowerment Scheme, towards the renovation and improvement works at the Hall.

This is a brief summary of the much fuller account of the work of the Council in the past year which will be available on the Brafield Village website shortly.

**Play Area Repairs**

The damage to the wooden climbing frame in the Play Area caused by vandalism has now been repaired at a cost to the village of £210
